An opportunity to visit interesting sights in the outskirts of Kuala Lumpur City. Cruise along the 'Ambassador Row', passing Istana Sharif Ali and Malay villages. Our first stop, the Royal

Selangor Pewter the largest pewter factory in the world, is renowned for high quality products with exceptional craftsmanship. During the tour of the factory, you will get a chance to learn the different processes, such as casting, filing, polishing, soldering, hammering and engraving of pewter products. Next, we stop at a Batik factory to witness the process of traditional batik printing using wax and dyes, producing exquisite Malay textile. Our last stop will be at the

limestone hills of Batu Caves. A flight of 272 steps will lead up to the sacred Hindu temple cave where the shrine of Hindu deity, Lord Murugah lies. Another cave, called the museum cave, is filled with images of deities and murals depicting scenes from the Hindu scriptures.

Explore a part of the 544-ha forest rich in diverse flora and fauna species in Forest Research Institute of Malaysia. Enjoy an interesting trek through the forest and learn about the many plant species in this part of the world. Some of the highlights along the nature trails include the crown shyness phenomenon of the kapur trees (Dryobalanops aromatic); various other unique tree features such as leaves, barks and buttresses as well as the serenity in the forest. If you are lucky, you may spot some wildlife such as monkeys, lizards and birds along the trails.

'Most intelligent city in Malaysia'

Approximately 50-minute drive out of Kuala Lumpur is Putrajaya, Malaysia's new federal administrative centre. The architecture in Putrajaya is predominantly modern Arabic in style. Our first stop will be the 14-hectre Taman

Warisan or Agricultural Heritage Park, a resource centre and a living museum showcasing the history and the glorious agriculture era. There are many varieties of fruit trees and plants, such as mango, rubber, cocoa, palm oil, durian, jackfruit, herbs, etc. A demonstration on the entire rubber-manufacturing process from the time it is tapped and churned out as fully smoked sheets will be shown during the tour. Next stop is at Putra Jaya Government Centre, where numerous new government complexes are located in this new township. Standing beside Dataran Putra and facing the Putrajaya Lake, is the Putra Mosque. Undoubtedly the most imposing structure, this pinkish mosque incorporates architectural elements from Turkestan, Kazakhstan and Morocco. The Prime Minister's office, Putra Perdana, is the eye catching building on the main hill with mixed architectural influences of Islamic and European cultures. Other interesting places include the 435-metre, three-deck Putra Bridge which provides vehicle, monorail and pedestrian access.

Pulau Ketam `Crab Island' Tour

After an hour drive from KL to Port Klang, and a 30-minute ferry ride, you will arrive at Pulau Ketam an entire fishing community living in a village where even the roads are built on stilts. Look out for fiddler

crabs, mud crabs, mudskippers and marshland birds. Take a leisure stroll to discover this rustic fishing village famous for its fresh seafood and observe the life of the local villagers as they go about in their daily chores.

After lunch at a local restaurant, we catch the ferry back to Port Klang. On the way back, we will drive by the fabulous Palace of the Sultan of Selangor. Occupying about 36 acres of beautiful parkland is the Sultan Salahuddin Mosque or Blue Mosque, famed for having the biggest dome in the country and some of the tallest minarets in the world. Our last stop is at Thean Hou Temple, one of the Chinese temples largest in South-Fast Asia.

Historical Malacca

(KULTO-09)

Discover the historic centre of Malacca, an UNESCO world heritage site. This historic colonial town is a living testimony to the multi-cultural heritage of traditional Asian and European colonial influences. Here

many battles were fought to gain control of this strategic base that facilitated the monopoly and control of the lucrative East Indies' spice trade. When the early European settlers departed, they left behind a treasure trove of historical buildings and landmarks synonymous with Malacca today.

Your tour will drive pass Bukit China or Chinese Hill - the largest Chinese cemetery outside of China. Stop at the foothill to view the Sultan's Well before driving through the Portuguese Settlement. Visit the famous gateway, 'Porta De Santiago' and the ruins of St. Paul's Church lined with 17th century Dutch tombstones.

Discover 'Red Square' - the salmon pink Dutch administrative buildings which today house the Malacca Museum and government offices. Visit Christ Church before proceeding for lunch. After lunch, visit the 'Abode Merciful Clouds' or the Cheng Hoon Teng Temple –

the only temple where you can find the doctrines of the 3 major local Chinese beliefs of Taoism, Buddhism and Confucianism. Lastly, take a stroll along the famous Jonker Street, which houses rows of antique local shops.

Kuala Selangor & Fireflies River

- Nature Park where you may spot the Silvered-leaf monkeys, rare species of birds, butterflies, etc. (Sighting of wildlife is not guaranteed).
- Flashing "Christmas trees" along the river bank

The quiet hamlet of Kampung Kuantan in Kuala Selangor has one of the largest firefly colonies in the world. On arrival, visit 'Kota Melawati', formerly known as 'Fort Altingsburg', the Royal Mausoleum, ruined Fort and the legendary 100 steps (a

fabled execution block). If you are lucky, you may spot the Silvered-leaf monkeys, rare species of birds and rare butterflies

At dusk, we proceed for a seafood dinner at a fishing village. After dinner, we take a short drive to Kampung Kuantan to board a typical Malay wooden row boat. The skilled oarsmen will row upstream into the darkness of the quiet night to witness one of nature's phenomena. As soon as your eyes are well adjusted to the dark, behold rows of flashing "Christmas trees" along the riverbank! The tiny twinkling orangey lights amongst the mangrove trees are synchronized,

rhythmic scintillation produced by thousands of fireflies. Truly a magical sight!

Aborigine Settlement & Elephant Sanctuary

Tour Highlights:

Approximately 1 hour 45 minutes drive towards the State of Pahang. First, a stop at an aborigine settlement to have an insight of the aborigine culture of Malaysia.

After that we will proceed to Kuala Gandah Elephant Sanctuary. This conservation centre is run by The Department of Wildlife and National Parks. The department's main task is locating, subduing and then translocating elephants from areas where their habitats have been destroyed due to development and urbanization. The centre strives to highlight the plights of elephants and educate the public about the importance of habitat and environmental preservation. Over the past 25 years, the centre has helped in preventing further decline of elephant population by relocating more than 300 wild elephants.

Tour includes elephant show, elephant feeding and for the brave, a water activity of bathing with the baby elephants in the river. Inclusive of lunch. (Please see notes).

An educational tour of nature and environment outside of a jungle. The Orchid Garden houses about 3000 species of orchid plants, of which 800 species are from Malaysia. This huge collection includes

hybrid and exotic species thriving abundantly on this one hectare of floral paradise. Truly one of nature's greatest creations, be awed as you feast your eyes in this colorful garden of Eden.

The beautiful and lush Butterfly Park is created with more than 15,000 plants to give it the look and feel of a rainforest. The Park is home to some 6,000 inhabitants of over 120 species. At the nursery you will learn about the life cycle and mating habit of these graceful insects. There is an interesting insect and creepy-crawlers museum. The largest enclosed aviary in South East Asia, the Kuala Lumpur Bird Park lies on a sprawling 8 acres of verdant valley terrain, houses over 5000 birds, mostly local and some imported. Come spot and identify the many types of nature's feathered beauties.

Explore Central market a former wet market transformed into an arts and craft centre. Visit the Sze Yeh

Temple, the oldest chinese temple in Kuala Lumpur. Enjoy the picturesque first brick mosque in Malaysia, jamek Mosque. The final stop is the Sultan Abdul Samad at the Merdeka Square (aka Independence Square); enjoy the spectacular sight of an array of heritage buildings.

- Get acquainted with our local produce from vegetables to various selections of seafood and poultry.
- Refresh yourself and understand the world of TCM (Traditional Chinese Medicine) and its herbal properties, sampling some herbal teas
- Witness the trades and occupation of the early days by the community in Chinatown such as sundry shop and what it has to offer.

Discover the Malaysian local food scene as you visit locations, which are entrenched with deep tradition and heritage in Petaling Street. Experience and taste the flavours of Malaysia's local favourites and delicious snacks. In this culinary walking tour, you explore the back streets and alleys of the City. Your local guide will explain about the history and influences of the Malaysian Chinese who have said to settle in Malaysia in the early 19th century.
