CITY & HERITAGE TOUR

PENTO-01

Departure : Daily at 9.00 am / 2.00 pm
Approximate Duration : 4 hours

Georgetown, the capital City of Penang, was named after King George III of England. Take a drive through historical Georgetown to visit the most prominent buildings of the colonial era that are now protected as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Stop at Fort Cornwallis that once belonged to the English East India Company and where Captain Francis Light first landed in 1786. Next, visit the State Museum, built in 1821 it showcases a fine collection of antiques as well as other historical relics on Penang's culture and heritage.

Enjoy an authentic trishaw ride through the heart of Georgetown and be fascinated by its charming colonial architecture, the modern skyscrapers of bustling Chinatown and all the colours of Little India. Stop at one of the most magnificent clan houses, Khoo Kong Si. The building features intricate carvings and woodwork bearing the mark of master craftsmen from China. Lastly, visit the majestic Thai Buddhist Temple, Wat Chayamangkalaram, which houses one of the world's largest reclining Buddhas at 33 metres. This gold-plated reclining statue has long fascinated foreign tourists.

Explore Penang Island also known as the 'Pearl of the Orient'. It first achieved fame during the famous spice trade era, trade in the island was recorded as far back as the Ming Dynasty in the 15th Century. Drive along the famous stretch of Batu Feringghi Road and enjoy panoramic views of the ocean. Head to the Batik Factory to see and to learn the traditional techniques of producing this exquisite Malay textile using wax and dye.

Pass by the lush and green landscape of local fruit and spice plantations. Stop at a fruit stall for an introduction to local fruits and the spices of nutmeg and clove. Next, visit the famous Snake Temple which was originally named the 'Temple of the Azure Cloud' in honour of the beauty of Penang's sky. Pit vipers now adorn the altars in the temple. On the way back, view Penang Bridge, one of the longest bridges in the world and which links the island to the mainland. Before returning to the hotel, stop by at the Penang Colonial Museum, experience the unique lifestyle of both the British administrators & wealthy merchants in Penang, appreciate the intricate art form from the past and the influences of the British on Penangites.

HILL AND TEMPLE TOUR

Known as the temple of 'Ten Thousand Buddhas', Kek Lok Si Temple is one of the largest and most beautiful Buddhist temples in South East Asia. Built on a hillslope, this unique seven-tier pagoda is a blend of Chinese, Thai and Burmese architecture and craftsmanship. Two not-to-be missed attractions are the 30-metre tall bronze



statue of the Goddess of Mercy (Kuan Yin) and the unique and sacred 'Pond of Longevity' which is home to hundreds of tortoises.. Tortoises are believed to be a symbol of longevity, strength and endurance in the Chinese culture.

Ascend the Penang Hill or Bukit Bendera via the funicular train up to 800 metres above sea level to escape the heat and enjoy the magnificent panoramic views of Georgetown and part of the mainland. Along the way, take in and appreciate the varied flora and maybe catch a glimpse of the elusive fauna. Penang Hill is Malaysia's oldest hill station and a place where residents and non-residents escape to seek respite from the lowland heat and humidity.

Enjoy the morning drive along the famous stretch of Batu Feringghi beaches and the panoramic views of the ocean. A brief stop is made at a traditional fisherman's village before heading out to the Batik Factory to see and learn the intricate techniques of producing this exquisite Malaysian textile using wax and dye. After driving past a dam and fruit plantations, stop at a fruit stall for an introduction to local fruits and spices such as nutmeg and clove. Next, proceed to the famous Snake Temple, also known as the 'Temple of the Azure Clouds' which was built in 1850. Be on the lookout for venomous pit vipers coiled around the altars and various other parts of the temple.

Stop for a local lunch before starting a journey to explore the fascinating Kek Lok Si Temple, also known as the "Pagoda of Ten Thousand Buddhas". This is one of the most beautiful and largest Chinese Buddhist Temple complexes in South East Asia. Then, ascend the Penang Hill

or Bukit Bendera via a funicular train up to a height of 800 metres above sea level. This is Malaysia's oldest hill station, visitors get the opportunity to enjoy a panoramic views of the island and the mainland.

On the way back, stop at the Royal Selangor Visitor Centre to participate in a 30-minute workshop on pewtersmithing. Using basic hand tools, bring home a gift to your loved one by creating your own simple pewter bowl, using similar techniques to those practised way back in the late 19th century. You may opt to be dropped off for some shopping at the Straits Quay Mall.

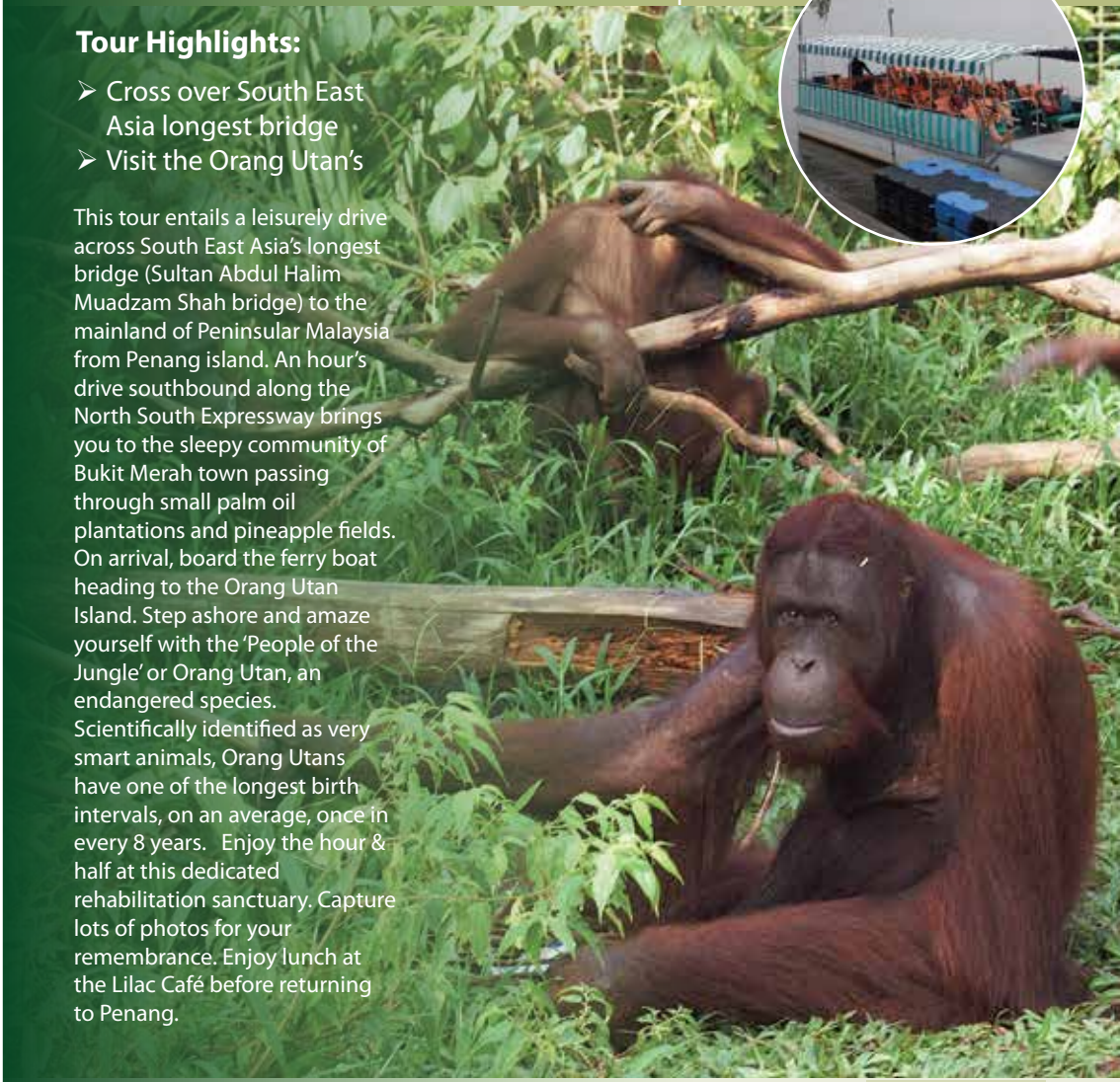

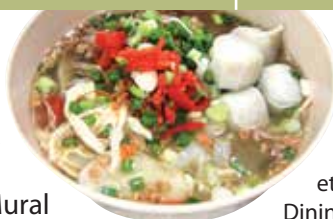

Kilim Karst Geoforest, the main conservation area within the Langkawi Geopark, is a great place for exploration and adventure due to its diverse mangrove forest and spectacular natural topography of imposing limestones rocks, fossils, caves, lagoons, beaches and seascapes. Enjoy the sight of magnificent eagles feeding upon fish in the mangrove ecosystem. The boat journey will take you through the thick mangrove forest fringed by limestone caves and hidden canyons where you can spot monkeys, kingfishers, monitor lizards and mud crabs.

On the way back to the hotel, stop and enjoy local coffee and snacks as you take in the local scene.

Journey back in time to glimpse the glorious lifestyle of the high esteem which Penangites held for the west and the British influenced their Eastern colonies with their perceptions of elegance, social status and formalities.
